

MSCA in Horizon Europe

- Budget: €6.6 billion
- Funds ALL RESEARCH AREAS
 (no thematic calls or priorities)
- Implemented via Annual Calls
- Promotion of attractive working and employment conditions
- Impacting researcher careers, organisations, structures

Doctoral Networks

- Consortium develops a joint four year innovative research and bespoke training project with organisations from at least 3 MS/AC
- Fully funds researchers to carry out a structured PhD
- Three modes: ETNs, EIDs, EJDs
- Proposed deadline: 16 November 2021
- Evaluation by scientific panel

























Postdoctoral fellowships

- Two types: European and Global
- Fully funds researchers with a PhD for up to three years to carry out a research and training project
- Eligibility: Max. 8 years post-PhD & Single mobility rule
- Optional 6 month placement in the non-academic sector at end of fellowship
- Proposed deadline: 15 Sep 2021























Staff exchanges

- Research and training project aimed to transfer
 knowledge between countries, sectors and
 disciplines (companies, non-profits, academia etc.)
- The project is implemented through staff
 secondments to different organisations in the consortium
- Max. 360 person months
- Salaries are not financed
- Proposed deadline: 09 March 2022























COFUND

- Single applicant Funding body, HEI, SFI Centre
- New or existing programmes providing international, inter-sectoral and interdisciplinary research training, as well as transnational and cross-sectoral mobility of researchers
- Two types: Fellowship and Doctoral
- 50% Co-fund from the EC (€200k-€10 million), synergies
- Proposed deadline: 10 February 2022

























MSCA and Citizens

- MSCA and Citizens, through the European Researchers' Night, aims to bring research and researchers closer to the public at large, to increase awareness of research and innovation activities and to boost public recognition of science and research education.
- Max. indicated funding: €150k
- Proposed deadline: 07 October 2021
